Substitution: It is at the discretion of the Organiser to accept substitution of horses after the close of entries.

Withdrawals: Withdrawals must be made by 4.00 pm on the day before the event or as stated in the schedule.

Athletes who do not declare their intention to withdraw are liable to a penalty at the discretion of the EA Branch concerned.

Draw: Draw will be available on nominate as soon as its finalised.

Number of Rides: No limit on number of horses per rider.

Under advice received from previous events and TD, we will no longer be accepting entries of same horse/rider combinations in both EA and PC classes. We are very sorry for this but riders must choose one or the other.

Discount: FCHT Member - \$10 discount – **EA CLASSES ONLY – NOT PONY CLUB CLASSES**

Camping & Stabling: This is to be booked with your nomination, not separately like in past.

Stables/Yards - \$15 per stable/yard per day Stable Bond - \$30 per stable – fully refundable if stable/yard left clean. No portable yards allowed.

Camping - \$25 per site per night

Facility Fee: \$25 for each and every horse for the duration of the event.

Other Fees: This event is subject to the \$20 EvQ Safety and Course Development fee.

Medical Levy: There is a \$10 medical levy charged per rider.

Competition Notes:

Saturday:

Dressage starts 8am

Show Jumping starts approx. 10am (if time allows all SJ will be done Saturday)

Sunday:

Cross Country – start at 8am.

Body protectors and back numbers compulsory for XC phase.

Protests must be in writing, accompanied by \$50.

- Dogs must be kept on leash at all times – no dogs on XC course on Sunday.
- This event will be run under EA Rules - Riders in any EA class must be a current EA member & horses in EvA95 and above must have current EA membership.
- Horses are recommended to have Base Registration. In Qld, this is free and can be completed online with EQ.
- It is the rider's responsibility to ensure they hold the necessary minimum eligibility requirements to enter their desired class. Please refer to Equestrian Australia National Eventing Rule 520.4

Class numbers: Won't exceed 40 per class. A waiting list will be held in case of scratchings.

Bikes/Scooters on XC - As per Rule EA 536.2.1.1

The Cross Country course must be walked on foot only; unless permission is given by the TD who will take guidance from the OC. Any permission to be posted on the notice board, if not posted walking on foot only allowed.

Medical Coverage

Medical Coverage at this event will be in accordance with the required level as specified in the Equestrian Australia National Eventing Rules, EA Annex D.1 CCN Medical and Veterinary Services, a copy of this document is located online at: <https://equestrian.org.au/eventing-rules>.

BIOSECURITY REQUIREMENT:

Horse Health Declarations are to be handed into the secretary's office on arrival to the grounds before the start of competition. Without a Horse Health Declaration, you will not ride! The form can be downloaded from: [Click here to download Horse Health Dec](#)

RIDERS NOTES

This event is operating with an industry COVID Safe Plan, please visit the following link to EQ COVID information from EQ and QLD Health <https://www.qld.equestrian.org.au/covid-19> for more information. Please follow the rules and keep us all safe, maintain social distancing and wash hands regularly. All riders and associates will be required to use the QLD Government 'Check in QLD' APP to check in and check out of the event.

Presentations – there will be presentations at the end of competition – this will be done as quickly as possible. Prize money will be paid directly into rider's account. It will be up to the winners and place getters of each class to forward their details through to receive prize money.

EA 505.3.5 CCN Prize Money

In all **Official Events**, including those confined to Juniors, prizes will be awarded to horses according to their placings and the number of starters in the class.

A minimum of **one prize shall be awarded for every 4 competitors**. A minimum of three prizes must be offered in every class. Third prize must not be less than the entry fee.

EvA80, EvA95 and CCN* prize money is optional.

Organisers may award additional prizes lower than the scale.

Application to vary this rule must be made to the respective State Eventing Committee and approved by the State Branch

NB: A starter is one which competed (i.e. started) in the dressage test.

XC Maps will be available via the Cross Country App – please download.

Riders will be required to print their own back numbers prior to arriving at the event. Please print two. Back numbers will be emailed out with the draw.

Volunteers – as always, we rely on volunteers to run all three phases of this event. Please provide a volunteer name and an email briefing will be sent out prior to the event.

Changes to Noms – Changes can be made by the competitor up until close of entries. After this, any changes will incur a \$25 fee.

ICE – Not available on grounds but can be purchased from Caltex North, 3 mins past the showgrounds on Highway.

Scoring – Nominate Scoring System will be used. Paperless dressage, access scores online.

Rider Rep – Brett Cattle – details will be on draw and at office

Swabbing Rules

- Under the EA competition rules this event may be selected randomly for Medication Control Program (Swabbing)
- Members should ensure that when attending activities, their EA Horse registration documentation should be available for the MCP Steward if their horses are either base registered or life registered

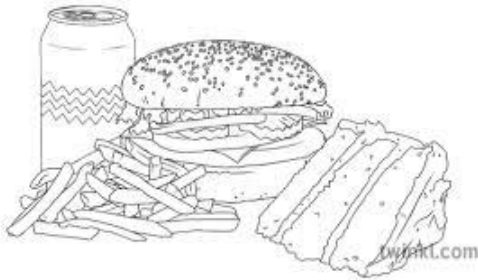
