**All PC riders must notify their DC of their entry**

**EA entries \$105** (includes ambulance & TEA levy per rider) –  
**non-TEA members will pay an additional \$100 fee**

This Event will be held under current Equestrian Australia/FEI Horse Trial Rules, and the National Eventing Rules January 2021 and all subsequent corrections and modifications as published by the FEI and EA with their provisions taking precedence. PLEASE NOTE Back Protectors and Medical Armbands will be compulsory for the x-country phase for all riders. EA tagged helmets are compulsory

EA riders – a copy of your entry will be sent to your club's president to check eligibility
