

Conditions of entry

Riders and spectators participate at their own risk. This event will be run under Pony Club Tasmania rules. The organisers reserve the right to cancel any classes or event: divide classes alter the advertised times; or refuse entry with or without stating a reason.

NO SMOKING ON THE GROUNDS

A horse and rider combination may only compete in one of Topsy, Beginner or Open. The Topsy and Beginner classes are for green riders and/or horses. Please be fair and reasonable when determining which ring to compete in and ask an official if you are uncertain.

Entrants in pony club classes must be in full PC uniform and a current member.

The show committee reserves the right to amend this program at any time without notice.

Competitors who are Non-PCT members must pay a \$10.00 day insurance. PCT members will need to produce evidence of current membership.

The judge's decision is final and no disputes entered into.

The rider's age is as of 1 January 2020

Full riding attire is not essential but dress must be neat and tidy. All riders must wear safety approved riding boots and helmets.

The novice events are for horse or rider who has never won a first at any show.

No classes will be held up for anyone-No exceptions!

No stallions or dogs allowed

Best Presented is not eligible for champion. Winners of respective classes are eligible for the champion class, all second place getters are to stand by.
