GENERAL INFORMATION

All classes will be run under PCASA rules.
Rules are available on the PCASA website: www.ponyclub.asn.au

- Pony club classes are open to all financial members or associates/seniors of an affiliated pony club on a qualified horse.
- PCASA rules for conduct of Pony Club One Day Events will apply to all classes.
- All PC riders must hold a current PCASA card and EA riders must show proof of current EA membership.
- EA riders must sign a waiver.
- Approved helmets, gear and riding boots must be worn by all riders.
- Gear check compulsory for ALL riders prior to commencing each phase.
- Medical armbands and A4 size body numbers must be worn for cross country.
- Entries may be limited and will be accepted on a first come basis.
- COVID safe rules and restrictions will be strictly adhered to. Please do not attend if you are feeling unwell or have been in contact with anyone who has tested positive to or suspected of having COVID-19 in the last 14 days prior to the event.

PROVISIONAL TIMETABLE

DRESSAGE: Commences 8.30am Saturday
SHOWJUMPING: Commences 10.00am Saturday
CROSS COUNTRY: Commences 9.00am Sunday

DRESSAGE TESTS - Pony club dressage test are available on www.ponyclub.asn.au. EA eventing dressage tests can be found on www.equestrian.org.au.

CROSS COUNTRY - The cross-country course will be open for inspection from approx. 3pm on the Saturday. Maps of the course will be available from the Secretary's office. Check the course maps on display for any late course alterations.

WATER - Competitors must bring water for their horses, both for drinking and washing.

DOGS - Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times. No dogs allowed on XC grounds on Sunday.

CATERING - Catering is available on both days including breakfast.

CAMPING - Camping is available on the grounds from Friday midday. Fee is \$25 per site for the weekend and can be booked with entry on Nominate. All campers will be notified by email prior to event where their allocated camp site is.

YARDS - A limited number of day yards are available at \$20.00 for weekend and can be booked with entry on Nominate. First in, first served basis. Note that yards are a significant distance from camping area. Campers may make their own yard in the area provided.

REFUNDS - No refunds after closing date without a vet or doctor's certificate. Requests for Refund must be submitted within 7 days of the event and will incur a \$10 handling fee.

PROTESTS - Protests must be in accordance with PCASA rules for the conduct of One Day Events.

LOCATION - Mountain Pony Club, Williams Road, Mount Barker Springs
Directions: Exit the freeway at Mt Barker and travel toward Mt Barker, turn left at second roundabout.
Well past the Golf Club turn right at roundabout into Springs Road and follow the signs to the grounds on Williams Road, Mt Barker Springs. If taking the Bald Hills freeway exit, follow road/exit roundabout towards Mt Barker, at the top of the hill turn left into Springs Road, then left again into Williams Road.
