

2022 QLD STANDARD BREED TRACK TO HACK SERIES FINAL CONDITIONS OF ENTRY (PLEASE READ CAREFULLY)

1. The lodging of any entry shall bind the exhibitor to the conditions of entry and the regulations set out here-in and the signature of any exhibitor on the entry form shall constitute acceptance of these conditions.
2. The Standardbred Association Queensland Inc. (SAQ) Committee shall have the power without giving reason to:
 - Reject or cancel any entry at any time
 - Alter the program, the scheduled event or start time
 - Remove any exhibitor from the show grounds for displaying abuse towards their horse
3. All Horses will have qualified at a Qld Agricultural Show in the current season. Combinations must have won a 1st, 2nd or 3rd place in a ridden Maiden or Beginners Ridden Standardbred class of any 2022 Qld Agricultural Shows that holds Standardbred Classes.
4. Substitution of riders is prohibited, except for Section 1 and Section 4 Grouped Finalist displays. If a competitor has qualified two or more horses in the series, they are permitted to compete with those combinations as qualified in Individual Sections 2 & 3.
5. All Exhibits must be able to be identified by their brands and or markings. Altering the appearance of an exhibit such as changing the coat colour or adding white markings is prohibited and may result in disqualification.
6. All exhibits must:
 - Be freeze branded on the neck with a recognised freeze brand.
 - Be previously or currently registered with an organisation such as Harness Racing Australia, Harness Racing New Zealand etc.
 - All horses are required to be 3 years and over.
7. Stallions will not be permitted to be handled or ridden by any person under 18 years whilst on the show grounds. Stallions must be fitted with correctly fitting headgear, and correctly fitting bit. Stallions are to be double tied when tied to floats or trucks.
8. All mares and geldings must wear correctly fitting headgear and be under control at all times.
9. Number holders are to be worn by all exhibits when competing in finals. Numbers will be supplied on the day of competition.
10. All finalists must supply a photo of their horse which will be used in the Grand Final Catalogue of Entries, along with information required on the Nomination Form. Photos can be emailed to events-show@saq.com.au or posted with Nomination Form.
11. SAQ Inc. will not be held responsible for loss of or damage or injury occasioned to any exhibitor or the property of any exhibitor for any cause what-so-ever.
12. The exhibitor and exhibits enter entirely at their own risk. In any case of an exhibit, whilst on the showgrounds causing or being the cause of injury or damage to any other exhibitor or exhibit, OR to the person or property of ANY member of SAQ Inc., its officers, officials and members from and against all damages, costs, claims, expenses or liabilities incurred with such an incident. The exhibitor shall be liable to SAQ Inc. its officers, officials and members for any damage or loss occasioned to any of the by the exhibit or exhibitors or agents.
13. All exhibitors must return a signed SAQ Liability Waiver Form along with their nomination. (Forms can be downloaded from our website: www.saq.com.au)
14. A Completed Horse Health Declaration Form must be submitted on arrival to the grounds.
15. All riders must wear properly fitted ASA approved helmets with chinstraps fastened in accordance with SAQ Risk Management Policy.
16. All handlers must wear closed footwear at all times.
17. Riders under the age of 18 years are not to wear long boots in any show class.
18. Entry Fees (less \$10 Admin Levy) will only be refunded upon production of a Veterinary Certificate verifying that an entered horse is unfit to compete.
19. SAQ Inc. reserves the right to test any exhibit to determine whether any drug or stimulant has been administered to such exhibit.
20. An exhibitor may not knowingly exhibit a horse that has been bred, sold, leased or produced by the judge or his/her employer.
21. An exhibitor may not show a horse judged by any member of his/her immediate family.
22. All competitors/participants must consent to have their personal information, including their name and contact details, and event photos being collected and shared with QOTT and Racing Queensland (RQ) for the purpose of the operation and administration of the QOTT Event Sponsorship Program.
