## COMBINED TRAINING

Consisting of two phases– dressage and showjumping - the scores for each are combined to determine the overall placing. This event is designed to test the courage, determination and all-round ability of the rider, as well as the training and conditioning of the horse.

Uniform and General Rules : as per PCNSW Rule book – Section 8  
Eventing - refer PCNSW website

Gear Rules are as per PCA National Gear Rules - Special Note that this rule book states for the Dressage phase: The carrying of a dressage whip is not permitted. Crops are allowed. Dummy or other spurs approved by the PCA National Gear Rules may be worn

**Classes 2 to 6 are for Riders who hold a signed Showjump Card**

Jump cards to be presented on the day. No card, No Jump.

**Transition Riders may only choose class 1 - these riders are in the Transition group at Rally days. “Learning to canter - but not capable of cantering in a group”. These riders will not have a jumping card.**

Class winners to receive Champion Sash.

Ribbons will be awarded to 5th place regardless of number in class
