ENTRIES & PAYMENTS: Close of entries is 11pm Wednesday 31st July 2024. All entries must be submitted via Nominate: www.nominate.com.au Entrants not members of NTSHA must pay day membership of \$10.00. Day Membership form to be completed, signed and provided to organisers prior to commencement of events.

**INSURANCE LEVY:** Equestrian Disclaimer is to be completed by all non members and forwarded to ntshowhorseassoc@gmail.com.

**REFUNDS:** Refunds are subject to the production of a Vet or Doctors certificate stating that the horse/rider was suffering a condition that would prevent them from competing. Incorrect entries WILL NOT be refunded, and a \$20 administration fee will be charged.

**COMPETITORS:** All competitors compete at their own risk.

**PROTEST:** Any protest accompanied by a non-refundable fee of \$100 must be in writing, and handed to officials, within 15 minutes of the incident. Ruling on the protest by the NT Show Horse Association Committee members present at the show will be final.

**FEED & WATERING:** Whilst horses are on the Reserve the feeding and watering of them is the responsibility of the owner/exhibitor.

**HEALTH:** All horses must be free from contagious disease. Veterinary inspections may be carried out at any time and horses which, in the opinion of the Veterinarian, show signs of contagious disease, shall, if the organisers so order, be removed from the Reserve by the exhibitor at his/herexpense.

**DRUG TESTING AND TREATMENT RULES**: It is the intention of the Drug Testing and Treatment Rules (Show Horse Council Australasia) all horses perform, at the time of competition, without any prohibited or banned substance/s within their system. A treatment sheet is required to be lodged to the NT Show Horse Assoc for any horse that has been administered any treatment, foreign substance, medication, drug, prohibited substance or banned substance, within 30 days of competition. Swabbing may be conducted on a random or for cause basis.

**ETIQUETTE:** Competitors at all times will display correct manners to judges and officials. Failure to do so will result in exclusion from the remainder of the Show and further action may be taken at the discretion of the organisers. EQUIPMENT: Saddlery must be in a safe condition to the satisfaction of the organisers, or the competitor will not be allowed to compete

**ILL TREATMENT OF HORSES**: I'll treatment of horses will not be tolerated and will result in automatic disqualification from further competition.

**TIMES:** Order of events shown in the program is a guide only. It is the responsibility of competitors to ensure they are ready for any event which they are entering. The organisers reserve the right to vary the order and times of events as they see fit. Classes will not be held.

**CHAMPIONSHIPS**: The second-place getters in all classes that qualify for Champion must stand-by, and the horse/rider that placed second to the horse/rider sashed Champion will be required for the judging of the Reserve Champion.

**MEASURING:** Measuring certificates are not required for this show. Organising Committee has discretion to move horses between classes where appropriate.

**ATTIRE:** Suitable/neat attire must be worn by all competitors. Any handler or rider, who, in the opinion of the organisers is not properly attired, will not be permitted to compete. Helmets must be worn by all competitors under the age of 18 years.

**AGE OF COMPETITORS:** for classes determined by age, age is at the day of competition.

APPROVED HEADGEAR: Riders/handlers Under 18 years of age must wear approved headgear to the current Australian (AS/NZ 3838; 1998 or European (EN 1384), or US (ASTNF 1163) standard. Riders 18 years of age and over are also permitted to wear bowlers and top hats.

**LED CLASSES** Horses entered in breed classes MUST have been registered. However, registration does not need to be current or financial. Only horses that are not eligible for a specific breed class are eligible for the "Any Other Breed" class.

**OFF THE TRACK THOROUGHBRED CLASSES (OTT)** - Thoroughbreds that are stud book registered and minimum barrier trialed. Registration details to be provided.

**HUNTER / HACK CLASSES:** Horses may only compete as either a Hack or Show Hunter **NOT BOTH.** 

**JUNIOR RIDERS:** Riders/handlers Under 18 years of age are not permitted to wear long boots in rider classes and Smartest on Parade. This includes gaiters and chapettes. Junior Handlers must wear approved headgear in led classes.

**PRELIMINARY HACK and HUNTER,** is one that has not been placed 1st, Champion or Reserve in an Open ridden Hack class/event at any Royal Show or has never been the Winner or Runner Up at the Grand National, any State HOTY Title or has never been the Winner of any HOTY Intermediate or Preliminary Title..

**TIMES:** Order of events shown in the program is a guide only. It is the responsibility of competitors to ensure they are ready for any event in which they are entering. The organisers reserve the right to vary the order and times of events as they see fit. Classes will not be held.

**Prizes/Presentations:** All prizes must be collected on the day, if they are not collected; the prize will be forfeited. Presentations will be mounted and will take place at the completion of each class

Stallions: Stallions are not permitted at this event.

**Judges Decision:** Judges decision shall be final subject to the outcome of any protest, report or investigation made within the Rules.





## **General Rules Specific to this event**

#### **Newcomer Hack/Show Hunter Classes**

- A Newcomer who is 3 years of age or over, and not competed under saddle (racing excepted) prior to 1
  January 2024 is eligible. The horse must be shown in a snaffle bridle only. Nose band permitted.
- A pony that has only competed in Leading Rein and has not competed off the lead is eligible to be considered a Newcomer.
- A horse/pony that has competed in breed classes under saddle is not eligible to be considered a Newcomer.
- The horse/pony must be registered with EA at the time of close of entries
- The horse must have a current EA Height Certificate.

#### **Track to Hack Feature Classes**

- This section is a feature section to showcase off the track registered Thoroughbreds. Places will be given in
  each section and the overall winner, second place getter and third place getter will be the combination that has
  gained the most points.
- To be eligible for the overall winner, competitors must compete in all three classes.
- Horses must be registered off the track thoroughbreds and racing name and a copy of breed registration must be provided.

#### **Appeals Committee**

Responsible for:

- dealing with protests referred to it respect of any matter occurring during or in connection with an EA event including the matters must be made to the Appeals Committee during its period of jurisdiction
- dealing with appeals against decisions of the Ground Jury and all cases of infringements of any rules for which the Ground Jury is not responsible
- inviting any person deemed necessary to help them reach a decision.at least one judge from the competition in which the incident occurred must be consulted. Any objection or protest must be made in writing, signed and handed to the Chief Steward (and forwarded to the Appeals Committee), with a fee of \$100 prior to the commencement of judging for the class concerned or within thirty (30) minutes after presentations of sashes. The Ground Jury shall determine the objection and will call such evidence as they think fit. If the decision goes against the protestor, he/she will forfeit his/her fee of \$100 and be liable for any expenses occasioned by the objection. Should the objection be allowed by the Ground Jury, the \$100 fee will be refunded.
- Should the protestor wish to appeal the Ground Jury's decision, he/she must lodge an appeal in accordance with the rules of Equestrian Australia.
- The decision of the Appeals Committee is final.

#### Program/Workouts

Final program of events, including required workouts will be available at least 48 hours prior to the event.

#### **General Information**

No dogs allowed. Riders and/or owners whose entries have been accepted, undertake to indemnify the committee against all claims, losses, suits and damages made against or suffered by the Committee by reason of any negligent act or omission on the part of any riders, trainers or attendants whilst they are attending, riding or otherwise handling a horse and agree that any act or omission on the part of such riders or attendants found in any action against the Committee to be negligent, shall be deemed to have been negligent for the purpose of any claim under this indemnity. Neither Equestrian NT, nor the organising committee of their appointed officials accept any liability for any accident, theft or illness to horses, rider, grooms or any person or property whatsoever.

#### **Close of Entries**

Entries close at 5.00pm (NT Standard Time) on Thursday 29<sup>th</sup> June 2023. Late entries will not be accepted for Official Classes, but late entries for Unofficial Classes may be accepted at the discretion of the Organising Committee. #### **Newcomer Rules**

- For horses three years of age and over that have not competed under saddle, excluding Racing prior to. To be ridden in a snaffle bit. Nose band permitted.
- Official height certificate at time of entry.
- 3 years of age or over at 1 August.
- All competitors must be full current EA Competitive members of EA in the State in which the event is being held.
- Eligible competitors to be members of DSHC
