Entries	All entries via www.nominate.com.au but must be approved by your DC Entries close 23 Nov 2024 *Entries will not be accepted without the name of a helper. For NTEC Riders the helper can be 'Dressage' if helping setup dressage arenas prior to event.
Veterinary	A veterinarian will be available for the SJ and XC phases.
Dogs	No dogs are allowed on the ground.
Smoking	No smoking on the grounds at any time
Parking	Please park safely and as directed by attendants.
Manure and Hay	All manure and hay must be removed and taken with you.
Triandre and ridy	Also no tape or litter is to be left on the ground.
Water	All riders need to bring their own water for horses and use.
Gear Dispensations	It is riders responsibility to make sure they have a copy of their dispensation to hand to provide to the gear checkers at each stage.
Gates will be open at	6:30am
Canteen	Canteen will be available all day
Back numbers	Will be issued on the morning of the event. Riders are to always wear back numbers and helmets when mounted, even in warm up. Please make sure hair doesn't prevent number being seen. If the back number is not returned, you will be invoiced for the replacement cost.
Tagged helmet and body protector	These will be checked at gear check. This is the responsibility of the rider.
Scratching's	All riders are to scratch via their DC at the earliest possible time.
Protests	If you have a query regarding your score, you must refer it to your club DC or nominated club representative, who in turn will follow it through on your behalf. Under no circumstances are riders or parents to approach the scoring team direct. Any queries, including marshalling queries, must be referred to your DC or nominated club representative.
