# RULES & REGULATIONS - RINGS A, B, and C

1. Competitors must perform to the following standards of dress: Hack or ridden classes: Cap or hat, (to conform to EFA/

PC safety standards), jodphurs or breeches, shirt & tie or stock, boots and jacket; or pony club uniform with shirt & tie. Led classes - dress must be neat and matching. Skirts or trousers may be worn or conventional riding attire.

- 2. **Maiden**: Horse or pony having never won a 1st prize in a hack class at any show or gymkhana, (Hack or Hunter)
- 3. Intermediate: Horse or pony having never won a 1<sup>st</sup>,2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> place in a similar event at any Royal Show (Hack or Hunter)
- 4. Age: Competitor's age on the day of the event.
- 5. Childs and Adults classes: You must choose to go in either Child's or Adults, same horse cannot do both classes..
- 6. Pleasure: Must be ridden in a snaffle bit, no whip, no spurs.
- 7. Best Educated, Pleasure and Pairs classes open to both Show hacks and hunters in rings A, B and C.
- 9. **Hunters**: For horses of showing more substance and larger in bone, may be asked to perform a hand gallop, good manners and quality of paces are paramount. Gear should be plain and workmanlike. If unsure if your horse is hunter or hack, please ask your judge at the completion of your led classes to classify your horse. Show hacks are not eligible to compete as a Hunter, and vice versa.
- 10. All First prize winners are eligible to parade for Champion. Once the Champion ribbon has been awarded, the 2nd place getter to that particular horse is eligible to compete for Reserve Champion.
- .11. In cases where an exhibitor's events clash, the exhibitor must choose between the classes, as no event will be held up for latecomers or clashing classes.
- 12. Stallions may compete in breed classes and ridden breed classes only. Stallions ARE NOT eligible to partake in any hack

Stallions must be handled by a capable adult, in an appropriate bridle or show halter. Any stallions showing any antisocial behaviour will be asked to leave the grounds. All stallions must be restrained in an appropriate manner when not being handled or shown. Please be mindful of children and mares on the grounds.

13. All horses entering for breed classes must be currently registered & financial with one or more of the following societies.

AHSA - Arabian Horse Society of Australia - all purebred Arabians and Arabian derivatives must be registered with this society.

ANSA - Australian National Saddlehorse Association

APSB - Australian Pony Studbook - breeds include Australian Pony, Mountain & Moorland breeds, Shetland, Hackney, Fiord

AQHA - Australian Quarter Horse Association

ASP - Australian Saddle Pony Association

ASH - Australian Stock Horse Society

Coloured Horses must be registered with a colour society: eg; Paint Society, Pinto, Appaloosa etc.

Dilute Horses must be registered with a dilute colour society:

Eg; Buckskin, Palomino, United Palomino White Buckskin &

Dun Association Ltd, Dilutes Australia etc. No false tails are

permitted in any palomino class.

RPSBS-Ponies registered with Riding Pony Studbook Society

Thoroughbred - must be registered with the Australian Stud Book (ASB) or Australian Jockey Club (AJC).

Warmblood / ISH - must be registered with AWHA, ACE or Irish Sport Horse society, or any other Warmblood registry. Welsh Pony & Cob Society - includes Welsh A, B, C, & D, and Part bred Welsh where no height limit applies.

Heavy Horses need not be registered with a society, but must show obvious heavy horse breeding and traits.

14.Other Breeds or Unregistered Horses. If your horse's breeds are NOT included in any classes on the day, or if you are currently unfinancial or your horse has no breed registrations you may enter in these classes. Alternatively if you choose to enter the

Other Breeds and Unregistered classes, you are not eligible for

any other breed class. The led hack classes are not considered a breed, so led hack entries are still eligible for the Other Breeds and Unregistered classes if they have no other breed classes. Do not enter these classes if you have entered or intend to enter any other breed class at this show.

- 15. The Committee reserves the right to alter the schedule and/or classes for any reason classes for any reason.
- 16. Classes may be split or combined depending on numbers of exhibits.
- 17. The judge's decision is final.
- 18. Protests: All protests must be in writing and lodged to the organisers within 15 minutes of the close of the event with a fee of \$50. The fee will be forfeited if the committee considers the protest frivolous. In the event of a protest being upheld, the next award in order shall take its place.
- 19. Registration papers must be produced at registration & also upon request in all breed rings. Random checks may be made at any time. If you are required to be a current financial member with a particular breed society to exhibit your horse, please DO NOT compete if you are not financial or not a member of that breed society. The onus is on you to know the rules of your breed society.
- 20. Indemnity: NCEC will not be responsible for any accident, loss or damage caused by competitors or horses. It is a condition of entry that every person competing shall not hold the NCEC liable for any loss or damage whatever and indemnity against any legal proceedings arising out of such an accident or loss. Each competitor is deemed to agree with these conditions.
- 21. All competitors must have signed a waiver/release prior to the commencement of the competition.
- 22. Results will be sent to RA&HS for consideration.

# RULES & REGULATIONS - RING D - Encourage

Restricted to horses who have **NEVER** won Champion Pony, Galloway or Hack under saddle at any Show or Gymkhana, leading rein excepted. Once you have won a Best Pony, Galloway or Hack in this ring as a horse/rider combination, you are **NO LONGER ELIGIBLE** to compete in future years.

- 1. Riders must choose to ride either in the hack classes in Ring D OR Rings A,B and C. You cannot swap between the encourage and open rings once the hack classes have commenced. You may however compete in your led and ridden breed classes. However breed classes will NOT be held for competitors in the encourage ring, you must make a decision and choose.
- 2. **Jackets are not to be worn in this ring**, Shirt and tie is to be worn, Jumpers or vests (PC or other) are optional.
- 3. Maiden: Horse or pony having never won a 1st prize in a hack class at any show or gymkhana.
- 4. Age: Competitor's age on the day of the event.
- 5. Pleasure: Must be ridden in a snaffle bit, no whip, no spurs.
- 6. Bridle Path hack. Horse to be obedient, worked on both reins & ridden with light contact, and required to perform a rein back.
- 7. Monte Carlo To be ridden at the walk only. Horses may be led, led with rider, or ridden. Arena is divided into 4 equal quarters, a pointer is spun, and those horses stopped in that particular quarter are then eliminated. Placings are then given to the final four horses left. Last horse left is the winner.
- 8. Led Championship First prize Led winners are eligible to parade for Champion. Once the Champion ribbon has been awarded, the 2<sup>nd</sup> place getter to that particular horse is eligible to compete for Reserve Champion.
- 9. Best Pony, Galloway or Hack classes. No reserve prize will be awarded
- 10. Champion Ridden Exhibit To be selected from the Best Pony, Galloway and Hack winners in Ring D. No reserve prize will be awarded.
- 11. In cases where an exhibitor's events clash, the exhibitor must choose between the classes, as no event in any ring will be held up for latecomers or clashing classes.
- 12. Stallions are NOT eligible to compete in Ring D.
- 13. The Committee reserves the right to alter the schedule and/or classes for any reason.
- 14. Classes may be split or combined depending on numbers of exhibits.
- 15. The judge's decision is final.
- 16. Protests: All protests must be in writing and lodged to the organisers within 15 minutes of the close of the event with a fee of \$50.
