## Mt Barker Annual Horse Show Rules

- **Do Not Ride On The Race Track**
- Approved safety helmets and riding boots to be worn at all times whilst mounted anywhere on the grounds.
- Age as at day of show
- Lead Rein is 8 years old and under for official and encourage.
- Hay is permitted, but please pick up all excess on the ground. Fill in any holes or damaged to the ground.
- All manure/hay to be placed in designated areas. Please clean up your area and place rubbish in bins.
- Use designated warm up areas to work your horse.
- **Horses must be lunged in enclosed arena by stockyards- no lunging on arenas or warm up areas.**
- District Hack– The horse/pony and rider must reside within the Plantagenet or Cranbrook Shires.
- Pony Club uniform may be worn in the Encourage rings, novelties and barrel race only.
- A Ground Fee of \$10 is payable for each horse/pony entered.
- \$2 Ambulance fee per rider – an ambulance will be on the ground all day for your safety.
- The Disclaimer must be read, understood and accepted on Nominate
- ALL entries are to be done online at [www.nominate.com.au](http://www.nominate.com.au)
- Instructions on how to use Nominate will be posted on the Mt Barker Horse Show Facebook Page
- One Nominate Entry per rider, if required multiple horses can be entered under the one rider.
- If multiple riders on one horse please email horse, riders and class details to [kimadams2@hotmail.com](mailto:kimadams2@hotmail.com)
- **Entries close Sunday 31st October 10pm**
- **\$20 per horse helper fee** – if you supply a helper for each horse this fee will be **reimbursed to your bank account by Nominate** within 1 week of the show. If you don't want to supply a helper you won't be reimbursed. If you want to supply a helper in order to have the \$20 reimbursed you need to include the following details when prompted to do so in Nominate: Helper Name, Helper Phone Number and Helper Email. If the helper is not on time or does not do the job satisfactorily it will be at the committee's discretion not to refund the helper fee. With any helper duty queries or if you can't do your allocated job for whatever reason please email Kim. We cannot run this show without your help and we very much appreciate it!

- Helper Duties will be emailed out on Wednesday 3rd of November

- In all sections the judge or committee has the right to amalgamate/change or split any class/s as they feel fit.

- Before entering a stallion please contact the committee for approval. Stallions must be identified as indicated in EA Guidelines: <https://www.equestrian.org.au/stallion-safe-practice>
- Entry fees will be refunded directly back to your payment method excluding the processing fee if the event is cancelled
- District Hack & Hunter Encourage classes not eligible for champion
- Mt Barker and Albany Ag Show High Point Showjumper – all heights above 60cm are eligible. The combination must enter at least 2 classes at each show. The highest 2 placing from each day will go towards the high point. Points: 1<sup>st</sup>-4, 2<sup>nd</sup>-3, 3<sup>rd</sup>-2, 4<sup>th</sup>-1. Prize will be split if a still equal points after a count back. Does not include Graduation, Improvers and Encourage finals.
- If you would like to donate your ribbons back to the show so they can be reused, it would be very much appreciated, please return them to the office or the tent at your ring. Thankyou
- ***Thankyou letters to Sponsors will be greatly appreciated by them.***

### **Official Ring Guidelines:**

- Official classes are RAS, EA and SHC Qualifiers.
- Horses or Ponies may only compete as either encourage or official not in both.
- Pony exhibits in hack classes can be ridden by rider of any age.
- Riders may compete in lead rein or first ridden but not both. Lead rein and first ridden riders cannot compete in any other classes on the day except novelties, barrel race and fancy dress. First ridden may also compete in the encourage showjumping ring however this will run concurrently and no classes will be held.
- Official horses can only enter either Hunter or Hack classes
- Novice classes are for Horses/Ponies that have not won more than 3 official first placing's in height, weight and ladies/gents classes only.
