Prizes: Rosettes 1st to 3rd Ribbon's 4th to 8th in open division. CDG Junior members (17 & under) separate placings in Prep, Prelim & Novice. Great South East OTT Series awards **OTT Riders** – 1st place \$100 & rosette, 2nd place \$50 & rosette, 3rd place \$25 & rosette in each competition Prep, Prelim & Novice. Also, a judge's choice in each of these competitions (\$40). OTT riders will be placed in separate division & only eligible for the OTT awards.

Membership for the OTT classes - Riders must be members of either RASDEG, PRARG or CDG to be eligible for entry. If the rider is not a member of either club, they will complete a day membership application on nominate as part of the nomination procedure. No fee will be charged in 2022.

To be eligible for OTT overall champion rugs at end of the series for Preparatory, Preliminary and Novice, the horse and rider combination must have competed at all 3 club events and achieved the highest points as per EA rules.

Eligibility of horses for OTT classes - Horses must have been named as part of the relevant studbook, for example, Thoroughbreds it is the Australian Studbook NOT EA. Please ensure you complete your horse's registered name in your nomination. Failure to do so may result in ineligibility.

Entry Fees: CDG members \$20 per competition, OTT entrants \$20 per competition | non-CDG members \$30 per competition – **Compulsory \$5 first aid levy per rider**

Conditions of entry: Entry is based on acceptance of the full list of [Conditions of Entry](http://www.caboolturedressage.org.au) which is available for viewing on our website, www.caboolturedressage.org.au. The onus is on the competitor to be aware of the rules that apply to the CDG Grounds and events.
