IMPORTANT PLEASE READ: Rules & Regulations

It is compulsory that all riders be members of EA. The competition is run under EA rules where applicable. Oxley College, the Education Department and those working on its behalf will not be held responsible for any accident, injury or damage, to any person, horse or equipment during this competition. It is the responsibility of the competitor to be aware of and comply with EA rules.

Schools and riders enter at their own risk. A waiver form must be completed and provided on arrival by parent or guardian for all students and handlers.

All competitors must wear a tagged and approved safety helmet.

If your helmet is not tagged, you can bring it to Completely Equine, 65 Bowral Road, Mittagong (0493-201-437)

One horse per one rider. One rider per one horse.

Riders can enter one dressage test, one show jumping round, four show rider classes and horsemanship.

Interschools uniform is required: School shirt, tie and jumper (weather dependent).

Bridle numbers will be required this year. If you do not have a bridle holder, there will be pins available to attach the number to your saddle cloth.

Show rider/Hacking: No long boots or gaiters allowed. Whips must not exceed 75cm incl. tassel. Pleasure Mount to be ridden with a snaffle bit.

Dressage: Gear checking will be done prior to dressage events near the dressage arenas; for other disciplines, gear checking is the responsibility of the competitor or his/her parent or guardian.

Showjumping: It is the competitor's responsibility to know when the courses are open for walking and the start time of each event. This information (including dressage draws) will be emailed to participants in the week prior to the event.

Please contact the organisers if you are unsure of what is required.

Close of entries: Friday, August 6, 2022

Late fees of \$20 will apply for entries submitted past the close date, and no refunds for withdrawals or scratching will be made after this date.

Dressage

- Riders entering Dressage may choose ONLY ONE of the following tests:
 - Prelim 1A
 - Prelim 1C
 - Novice 2B
 - Elementary 3B
- If a horse is graded, it must compete at its graded EA level or above as per EA Dressage rules.
- Gear checks will be completed before the rider enters the arena.
- Riders will be required to use the most recent EA tests.

Showjumping

- Riders will compete in 1 round of showjumping.
- Format will be Super Two Phase.
- Heights:
 - 60cm
 - 75cm
 - 90cm
 - 105cm
- EA rules apply

Show Rider/Hacking

- Classes will be run in Year Groups (7-8, 9-10, 11-12)
- Classes will include:
 - Best Presented (mounted)
 - Educated Mount
 - Rider Class
 - Pleasure Mount
 - Consolation

Riders Years K-6

Dressage

- Riders entering Dressage may choose ONLY ONE of the following tests:
 - Lead Rein/Preamble (K-2 only)
 - Prep E (ridden on full size arena)
 - Prelim 1A
 - Nov 2A
- Parents will walk riders on the lead rein for Preamble test.
- Parents are allowed to call instructions for all ages and tests.
- If a horse is graded, it must compete at its graded EA level or above as per EA Dressage rules.
- Gear checks will be completed before the rider enters the arena.
- Riders will be required to use the most recent EA tests.

Showjumping

- Riders may compete in 1 round of showjumping.
- One Round will be Super Two Phase format.
- Heights:
 - 25cm (K-2 only)
 - 45cm
 - 60cm
 - 75cm
- EA rules apply

Show Rider/Hacking

- Classes will be run in Year Groups (K-2, 3-4, 5-6)
- Classes will include:
 - Led Pony
 - Rider Class (may also be led for riders under 9 years old)
 - Pleasure Mount
 - Fancy Dress (for K-2) and Pairs (for 3-4 and 5-6)

AWARDS

Dressage and Showjumping:

Ribbons awarded for **1st to 8th place** in each test/height for each year group (K-2, 3-4, 5-6, 7-8, 9-10, 11-12.)

Show Rider/Hacking:

Sashes awarded **for Champion and Reserve Champion Riders**; Ribbons awarded for **1st to 8th place** in each class for each year group (K-2, 3-4, 5-6, 7-8, 9-10, 11-12.)

Year Group Overall Champion:

Rosettes and Saddlecloths awarded to one winner in each year group (K-2, 3-4, 5-6, 7-8, 9-10, 11-12.) based on highest overall points for the day.

Year Group Reserve Champion:

Rosettes awarded to one winner in each year group (K-2, 3-4, 5-6, 7-8, 9-10, 11-12) based on second highest overall points for the day.

Perpetual Trophies and medals will also be awarded on the day.
