
## Information for Competitors

#### **Entry Fees**

- EA/PE Competitions for CDG members \$35 per comp
- EA/PE Competitions for non-CDG members \$45 per comp
- EA FEI Competitions for CDG members \$45 per comp
- EA FEI Competitions for non-CDG members \$55 per comp
- Day yards \$10 per day to be booked with entries payable to CDG
- Stables & camping to be booked direct with QSEC via www.nominate.com.au

Compulsory \$25 Administration/Facility Fee (non-refundable) per horse Compulsory First Aid Levy \$5 (non-refundable) per rider

- Compulsory QSEC Ground Maintenance Fee \$6 per horse QSEC indoor will be used on Saturday & Sunday for higher level competitions
- Entry fees for all competitions will only be refunded where a **Doctor's/Vet Certificate** is supplied within 24 hours of the event.
- Ponies are eligible to enter any competition. Depending on number of ponies entered there may be separate divisions. Where there are separate Pony Divisions separate rosettes will not be awarded for AOR or Youth.
- EA & EA FEI Champions & Reserves will be awarded to combinations achieving at least 60% or higher in both competitions at the respective level.
- Championships: Small Tour Champion is combined results PSG & Intermediate I, Medium Tour Champion is combined results Intermediate A & Intermediate B, Big Tour Champion is combined results from Intermediate II & GP
- Champion in the Pony Divisions will only be awarded if there are 6 or more ponies competing in each competition & achieve a minimum of 60% in both competitions at the respective level. Awards to be advised.
- Amateur Owner Rider There will be rosettes and rugs for champions & rosettes & prize for reserves for the AOR competitions sponsored by Treadlite NZ. - AOR rosettes will be awarded to 6<sup>th</sup> place in all AOR competitions.
