Eligibility

Riders must be financial members of the Southern Districts Dressage Club, or take out day membership to the SDDC for the competition.

Tests

A maximum of 2 tests per horse/rider combination are offered.

Helper Duties

Riders may self - help for one horse only. If riding more than 1 horse, an additional helper will need to be provided or an additional helper fee of \$50 will be payable.

While every endeavour will be made to allocate duties requested, this not always possible, and **you might be allocated another duty by the organisers**. Please report for your helper duty 10 minutes prior to your scheduled helper duty time.

Catering

As this is a 'No Frills' dressage competition, there will be no catering service provided on the day so please bring own food. SDDC are promoting the reduction of single use plastics so ask people to bring their own water bottles.

Yards and Camping There are yards and camping available at the AEC however no powered sites. If yards are used they must be cleaned of manure and hay, and the gate closed, before leaving the AEC. For camping fees and booking visit the AEC website.

Refunds and Scratchings. Entry fees will not be refunded after the closing date of entries unless a medical or veterinary certificate is produced within 3 days of the completion of the event (**21 August 2024**), and in such cases, there will be a full refund less an administration fee of \$10.
