

Important Information & Advice

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY- PLEASE ENSURE YOU READ AND COMPLY

- This is not an EA Event, but the Event will be run under EA National Jumping Rules - Jan 2025.
- EA Approved Riding Helmets are compulsory. All Helmets must be tagged with a Yellow EA Approved Helmet Tag to enter the Warmup Area and Compete.
- Dress Code-White, Light or Beige Coloured Jodhpurs, Collared Shirt with Sleeves, Show Jackets to be worn in all height Classes.
- All participants must be Members of Hastings Valley Showjumping Club HVSJC

- All entries are to be completed via Nominate [Nominate Equest | Competition Details](#)
- Three starts per horse, per day (this includes a Grand Prix class).
- Only one entry per horse for the Grand Prix class.
- Ground Fees are \$10 per horse per day
- Stabling is \$10 per horse per day
- Camping Fees are \$25 for the weekend.
- Placings to 4th place. Rug for winner of each class.
- Bump in from 10am Friday 31st July to late Sunday 2nd August. Later departure to be organised with Show Society.
- Preference and allocation for camping (powered/unpowered) and stabling will be given to Travelers from out of the area at the discretion of the committee
- Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Event Committee; \$20 Administration fee may be charged after entries close. Scratchings after event closure of entries must be accompanied by vet or medical certificate.
- Draws will be posted after entries close. Competition will be run in draw order
- Please make sure you are warmed up and ready to go in your draw order for each Class. Classes will not wait for riders who are not ready.
- The HVSJC has Insurance with Horse Sport Australia. All riders are encouraged to have their own Accident & Injury Insurance.
- Warm up Area is limited to 5 horses at any given time. Please observe Red Flags to the Right when Jumping a practice Jump.
- Any disputes or protests must be lodged with the Event Committee within 10 minutes of the class ending, along with a \$50 non-refundable protest fee. The event committee's decision will be final.
- Camping & Stabling Fees must be paid in advance upon entry Via Nominate. Stables must be utilised for this event for those riders traveling, and own yards are not allowed.
- Well behaved dogs are welcome; however, you must clean up their mess and be always kept on leads.
- Please ensure you secure valuables and parking under trees is at your own risk. The club accepts no liability for any loss.
- The Event Committee reserve the right to decline entries at their discretion, without giving an explanation.
- Please pick up all waste and place manure in the areas provided.
- Volunteer levy of \$50 applicable per rider. This will be reimbursed after the event if your duty has been marked as complete.
- The Camden Haven Show Society will have the canteen open on Sunday from 8am.
