



Congratulations on being accepted to compete in the 2026 Royal Adelaide Show, Horses in Action Competition

We are pleased to be working with Nominate to facilitate the stable and locker bookings for this year's event.

Opening of bookings will be staged and exhibitors will receive individual emails with login details to facilitate their booking.

You will not be able to book any stable or locker till you receive your booking email!

For 2026 we are introducing a stable cleaning bond.

Following you will find information that will help assist you in preparing for booking your stable and locker requirements. Please read the following information carefully and do not hesitate to give us a call if you have any questions.

We can't wait to welcome you back to the Royal Adelaide Show this September!

Stable and Locker bookings will be available following the completion of acceptances.

Harness and Exhibitors with 5+ Horses will have access to the system first

- From Monday 20 July – All other sections will have access to book

No one can book stables or lockers without their login and password – **which will be date locked!**

ALL STABLE BOOKINGS WILL REQUIRE YOUR HORSES EXHIBIT NUMBER TO COMPLETE YOUR BOOKING

All stable bookings close at 5:00pm (CST) Monday 3 August

No bookings will be taken outside of these times

The onus is on the exhibitor to ensure they have booked for the correct days

Please read the following information carefully before proceeding with your bookings.

- The Society reserves the right to alter stable and locker allocations at any time should such an action be considered necessary and may allocate another stable or locker to the exhibitor.
 - Exhibitors with less than five horses may not apply for more than one locker. Any exhibitor with less than five horses found to have booked more than one locker will forfeit their booking and all monies paid.
 - Should the number of applications received exceed the number of lockers available, the Society will require exhibitors with one horse to share a locker with another exhibitor.
 - Exhibitors will need to supply the name/exhibit ID number of the horse booked for each stable as well as the height of the horse. This will be used to confirm all bookings meet the outlined criteria.
 - An exhibitor may act as the stabling contact for another exhibitors and book stables and lockers on their behalf, however, will be required to provide all exhibitor IDs at time of booking. Exhibitor ID's can be found on the entry receipt or list of entries. Exhibitors found to be booking stables for horses not registered to compete will forfeit their booking and all monies paid.
 - The first day a stable or locker can be booked for is Wednesday 2 September and the last day a stable or locker can be booked is Saturday 12 September.
 - This is a limited number of slightly larger stables (3.4m x 3m instead of standard 3m x 3m). These are for horses over 16.3 hands ONLY. Smaller animals booked into these stables **will** be relocated.
 - **There is strictly no overnight camping in stables or lockers!**
 - All other information in the Competition Schedule is still valid and should be read in conjunction with this document.
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FEES

Please Note: The Stabling and Locker system used at the Royal Agricultural and Horticultural Society of South Australia is powered by Nominate and therefore your credit card statement will show a charge from: NOMINATE PTY LTD MILBONG.

Stables: \$40 per day/night

Bedding: \$120 per stable (8 bales)

Lockers: \$20 per day/night

Stable Bond: \$100/stable

A booking fee will be applied to the final total amount for all locker and stable bookings.

Stable Bonds will be eligible for refund only after inspection of stables/lockers following your departure.

Refunds will be processed through Nominate and will be completed after the conclusion of the show. If you have not received your stable bond refund or been advised why your refund is not being processed by 4 October 2026 – please advise the Show via email.

CANCELLATIONS

- Exhibitors may cancel a booking and receive a full refund (excluding the booking fee) until **5:00pm (CST) Monday 13 August**. Cancellations can be made by contacting **Nominate** on **+61 7 3118 9555** (9am to 5pm Monday to Friday)
- Bookings cancelled after 5:00pm **Monday 13 August** will not be refunded; unless approval is given by the RA&HS.
- Any request for refund should be **received in writing** to entries@adelaideshowground.com.au. Medical and/or veterinary certificate documentation must also be provided. Refunds will be considered on a case-by-case basis.

In addition to the identified harness area on the site map, there will be space made available for harness vehicle storage in the tin dairy and at the back of the brick locker area. Exhibitors will be supplied with further information on arrival to the Adelaide Showground.

There may be some stables or lockers blocked by the Royal Adelaide Show at the time of bookings opening. These will be made available to exhibitors only if all other allocations are exhausted.

BOOKING CONDITIONS

STABLES

- An exhibitor who has not occupied the stable that has been allocated to them by 8.00 am on the day of allocation (within prior arrival time advise being supplied) is advised that the stable will be deemed vacant, and all payment received by the RA&HS in association with the stable/s will be forfeited. The stable will likely be reallocated to an alternative exhibitor.
- Stables are to be used for the sole purpose of stabling horses only, the use of the stable for any other purpose such as accommodation, storage of fodder, bedding or tack etc is strictly forbidden. Any exhibitor acting in breach of this regulation will be fined \$200 for each stable per day and may, at the discretion of the Committee, be disqualified from competing at the current Show, in which event any Award that the exhibitor may have won at that Show is also forfeited.
- Exhibitors of horses which have been allocated a stable may remove their horses at a time approved by the Stabling Coordinator (but not before a Grand Parade).
- All stable bookings must state the exhibit number of the animal at time of booking.

BEDDING

- Shavings will be the only horse bedding used on the Showgrounds.
- All stables have been secured with cable ties: any exhibitor found cutting ties, entering stables/lockers not allocated or removing bedding from stables not allocated to them will be fined, and may be asked to leave the premises.
- The cost of bedding is included in the stall fees and must be purchased at the same time as stables are booked.

- Bedding will be placed by the Society but is the responsibility of the exhibitor to lay out.
- Exhibitors of hacks occupying a stall in the second half of the Show will be issued two bedding tickets by the Stabling Coordinator at the time of stall allocation.
- Exhibitors may buy additional bags of shavings from the fodder store during the Show.

STABLE CLEANING

Exhibitors will always, to the satisfaction of the Society:

- Keep each stall allotted to them and their animals in a clean and proper condition throughout the Show.
- Clean out their stalls regularly. Refuse must be deposited in manure bins provided.
- Manure must not be deposited in alleyways or general-purpose rubbish bins.
- General purpose rubbish must not be deposited in manure bins.
- Leave each stall allotted to them and their animals in a clean and proper condition on departure. Failure to do so will result in stable bonds not being refunded!

LOCKERS

- Exhibitors with less than five horses may not apply for more than one locker. Any exhibitor with less than five horses found to have booked more than one locker will forfeit their booking and all monies paid.
- Exhibitors must supply their own locks for their locker. Items left in lockers are the exhibitor's responsibility, and no liability will be accepted by the Society for damaged or lost items.
- A limited supply of padlocks and keys will be available for sale through the Stabling Coordinator and main office during The Show.
- Should the number of applications received exceed the number of lockers available, the Society will require exhibitors with one horse to share a locker with another exhibitor. The same fee applies whether a locker is shared or not.

After the stable and locker booking period close, some brick stables may be made available to harness exhibitors to use as lockers. Exhibitors should in the meantime book what lockers they require, and exhibitors will be provided further information should this option become available.

CARE OF STALLS/LOCKERS

- Numbers or any other identification marks which may have been placed on or in a stable or locker by the Society, whether by placard, painting, posting or any other means, must not be removed, disfigured or altered in any way, nor shall any other notice, number or mark be placed in or upon any stall or box other than by the order of the Society.
- Screens, rugs or any other obstruction which may obscure the interior of the stall to the public must not be used during daylight hours.
- Stables shall be used only by animals entered for competition and for the purpose for which they have been allocated to the exhibitor.
- The consumption of intoxicating liquor in lockers and adjacent areas is forbidden.
- The observance of the above regulations will be the responsibility of the exhibitor. Infringement of these regulations will result in the cancellation of the stall or locker in question and all money paid will be forfeited.
- There is no camping or sleeping allowed in the stables or anywhere on the showground premises.

- Failure to adequately clean your stable/locker before leaving the showground will result in the forfeit of the stable bond.
